

The Catherine Cheater Scheme of Work for Spanish Year 5 Sample Parcel

Suggested Daily Parcels - Lesson Five

A The time: ¿Qué hora es? Y cuarto/y media

You will need space for this activity. Give each child a time (e.g. la una y cuarto, las dos y media) and ask them to walk in a circle in a clockwise direction. Whenever you say Uno, dos, tres the children respond with ¿Qué hora es? You then say a time. If you call a time on the hour (e.g. Son las dos), the children with dos in their time change places. If your time includes y cuarto / y media those children change places.

B Pronunciation practice: ch

 Say the following tongue-twisters (trabalenguas) and ask the children to repeat after you:

Chundo charla con Conchita en Archanda.

Charo chiquitita chincha chinches.

Charlie chispea en China.
